### **You may be eligible for health benefits if you:**

- Served in the active military, naval or air service and were discharged under conditions *other than* "dishonorable."
- Served in the Reserves or National Guard, were called to active duty, and completed the full period of your duty.
- Served in the Women's Army Auxiliary Corps (WAAC) or Flew as a Women's Air Force Service Pilot (WASP) in WWII
- Experienced sexual trauma while serving in the military.

*Each veteran is unique. Contact the Eligibility Office to determine your individual eligibility status.*



### **To determine eligibility for VA health care services:**

Bring the following to the Eligibility Office at the VA:

- **DD-214** (discharge document)
- Your latest **tax return**

*Eligibility for other insurance does not affect your eligibility for VA Health Care.*
